Criteria:

1. A minimum cumulative GPA of 2.8 is required. A TCU Cumulative GPA of 2.8 is also required for continuing the award after the first year.
2. Financial eligibility must be demonstrated. The TCU Financial Aid Office will evaluate the applicant’s eligibility upon receipt of the results of the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).
3. Applicants must be black students who are graduates of Tarrant County, Texas high school.

Deadlines:

1. Freshman applicants must apply for admission by February 7.
2. Transfer applicants must apply for admission by March 27.
3. The results of the FAFSA and Harriet Tubman Scholarship application must be received prior to April 3.
