- 1. A minimum cumulative GPA of 2.8 is required. A TCU Cumulative GPA of 2.8 is also required for continuing the award after the first year.
- 2. Financial eligibility must be demonstrated. The TCU Financial Aid Office will evaluate the applicant's eligibility upon receipt of the results of the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).
- 3. Applicants must be black students who are graduates of Tarrant County, Texas high school.

Deadlines:

- 1. Freshman applicants must apply for admission by February 7.
- 2. Transfer applicants must apply for admission by March 27.
- 3. The results of the FAFSA and Harriet Tubman Scholarship application must be received prior to April 3.

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
