



**2020-2021 Martin Luther King, Jr. Scholarship
Criteria
Deadline: May 15**

Selection will be based on an expressed commitment to a career in service to humanity. ‘Service to Humanity’ is broadly defined as a career that is consistent with the values and purposes reflected in the life of Martin Luther King, Jr.

1. For freshman applicants, a high school class rank of top 25% is required.

For current students a TCU Cumulative GPA of 3.0 is required and for transfer students a transfer GPA of 3.0 is required.
2. Financial eligibility must be demonstrated through the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).
3. An essay of not more than 750 words on an applicant’s career plans with the focus on how the proposed career is seen as being in ‘service to humanity’ must be submitted with the application.
4. Letters of recommendation from two TCU Faculty, Staff, or High School Teachers, Counselor or Principal must be submitted in support of the application.
5. Preference will be given to minority applicants.
6. Application and essay must be submitted through your TCU Financial Aid Portal. Letters of recommendation must be submitted to the Office of Scholarships and Student Financial Aid by May 15.
7. Scholars must re-apply annually.
