### First – Time Applicants:

1. Submit an essay (approx. 500 words) reflecting your theological development and your understanding of your commitment to a full–time career in congregational church ministry.
2. Have the minister and chair of the board of your church complete the certification document located on page 2.

### Renewal Applicants:

1. Submit an essay in which you identify ways in which you have grown in your theological understanding as well as your understanding of your own commitment to a vocation in full–time congregational church ministry.
2. Repeat the certification process located on page 2.
3. You are required to schedule an interview with the Chair of the Department of Religion or Coordinator of Advisement.
