## Personal/Professional Development Grant (P/PDG)

To make education more accessible to working students, TCU offers a limited number of "Personal/Professional Development Grants" for part-time students enrolled in credit courses. **Awards are limited and granted according to availability of funds.** These grants are available to students with higher income brackets than are usually considered for financial assistance.

## **REQUIRED**

Complete the 2022-2023 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at <a href="www.fafsa.gov">www.fafsa.gov</a>. TCU reserves the right to select the student for verification of FAFSA information and to contact applicant's employer for tuition reimbursement verification.

#### AMOUNTS OF GRANTS

The P/PDG provides 40% of tuition for up to six (6) hours each semester. A total of six (6) hours is allowed for all summer sessions combined.

#### INCOME LIMITATIONS

In order to be eligible, the adjusted gross income may not exceed:

- \$81,139\* for independent, single students without dependents
- \$100,699\* for married students or single students with dependents
  - \*Note: Income ceilings and amounts of P/PDG are subject to change.

#### **OUALIFICATIONS**

Applicants must be:

- Year-round part-time students (enrolled for 11 hours or less)
- Accepted to the University before the P/PDG application may be considered
- U.S. citizens or permanent residents of the U.S.
- At least 22 years of age by the final day of late registration
- In good academic and financial standing at all colleges and universities attended

# HOW AND WHEN TO APPLY

Applications will be accepted through the late registration date of the term for which the P/PDG is requested. Awards are not retroactive. Applications are accepted by mail, in person, or fax. In order to verify eligibility, TCU reserves the right to verify applicant's FAFSA information through the verification process and to contact an applicant's place of employment regarding employee tuition grants or reimbursements.

#### **STIPULATIONS**

This grant is not available to individuals who are receiving other TCU administered aid. Limited funds are available; therefore, awards are provided on a first-come, first-served basis. The P/PDG in combination with tuition reimbursement from employer may not exceed total cost of tuition.
