First – Time Applicants:

2. Have the recognized leader of their religious organization, and where applicable, the chair of the board of their religious organization, complete the certification documents.

Renewal Applicants:

1. Submit an essay in which you identify ways in which you have grown in your theological understanding as well as your understanding of your own commitment to a vocation in full-time religious leadership.
2. Repeat the certification process located on page 2.
3. You are required to schedule an interview with the Chair of the Department of Religion or Coordinator of Advisement.
