- 1. Submit an essay in which you identify ways in which you have grown in your theological understanding as well as your understanding of your own commitment to a vocation in full time congregational church ministry.
- 2. Repeat the certification process below.
- 3. You are required to schedule an interview with the Chair of the Department of Religion or Coordinator of Advisement.
