Personal/Professional Development Grant (P/PDG) Graduate Students enrolled in 8 hours or less per semester

To make graduate education more accessible to working students, TCU offers a limited number of "Personal/Professional Development Grants" for graduate students enrolled for 8 hours or less per semester and enrolled in credit courses. These grants are available to students with higher income brackets than are usually considered for financial assistance.

REQUIRED

Complete the 2019-20 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at <u>www.fafsa.gov</u>. TCU reserves the right to select the student for verification of FAFSA information and to contact applicant's employer for tuition reimbursement verification.

AMOUNTS OF GRANTS

The P/PDG provides <u>l/4 tuition credit</u> for up to six hours each semester. A total of six hours is allowed for all summer sessions combined. The P/PDG is not available for the Winter Intersession Term.

INCOME LIMITATIONS

In order to be eligible, the adjusted gross income may not exceed:

- \$74,145* for independent, single students without dependents
- \$92,018* for married students or single students with dependents

*Note: Income ceilings and amounts of P/PDG are subject to change.

QUALIFICATIONS

Applicants must be:

- Graduate students <u>enrolled for 8 hours or less per semester</u> year round. Enrollment of 9 or more hours will cause cancellation of this grant.
- Accepted to the University before the P/PDG application may be submitted.
- U.S. citizens or permanent residents of the U.S.
- At least 22 years of age by the final day of late registration
- In good academic and financial standing at all colleges and universities attended

HOW AND WHEN TO APPLY

Awards are not retroactive. Applications are accepted by mail, FAX or in person (Sadler Hall 2008 between 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. Monday through Friday.) In order to verify eligibility, TCU reserves the right to verify applicant's FAFSA information through the verification process and to contact an applicant's place of employment regarding employee tuition grants or reimbursements.

STIPULATIONS

A new application is required each academic year. This grant does not renew automatically. Students are required to file the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). This grant is not available to individuals who are receiving other TCU funded aid. College of Education and Brite Divinity students are not eligible for this grant due to aid offered through their specific programs. Other graduate programs not eligible for this grant: Masters of Liberal Arts or Criminal Justice, DNP –Nurse Anesthesia, MSN/DNP-Nursing. Awarding of this grant is contingent on funds availability. Funds may be limited and may be awarded on a first-come, first-served basis.
