

Request for an Additional Semester of TCU Funded Scholarships and Financial Aid 2019-2020

Money relinquished by graduating seniors provide funding for scholarships and grants for the next entering class. Consequently, the result of extending an award for a student who has exhausted their eligibility could result in a reduction of funding for a new student entering the University during that time period. Therefore, all requests for extensions are subject to the availability of funds after awards are made for new students, and after all aid has been renewed for eligible returning students.

One additional semester is automatically provided for students in a single program of study that required more than 124 credit hours for graduation. Extra time needed for double majors, additional minors and changes in major do not qualify for this exception.
